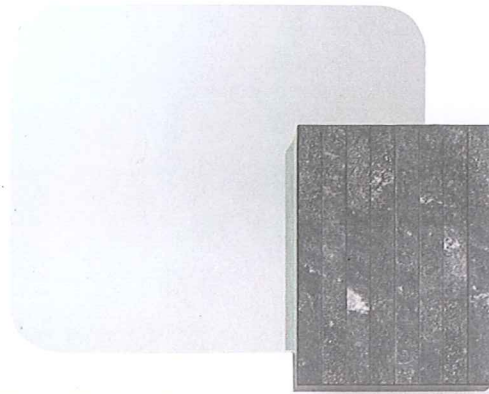

A Diesel and Scavolini Collaboration

As part of the Diesel Living collection, Diesel and Scavolini, two of Italy's most eye-catching contemporary brands, have come together to create a modular, modern kitchen imbued with Diesel's edgy spirit.



Designed for a smaller, urban home, the "Diesel Social Kitchen" follows the company's ethos of "premium casual living", where the kitchen acquires all the verve and energy of a party. A blend of Diesel's style and Scavolini's experience, the "Diesel Social Kitchen" features unusual materials, new but time-worn, with original colors and shade variations.

Large, natural, simple materials, such as wood, steel and glass, processed together with metal, define the kitchen; the doors are in oak, processed to provide a natural, knotted look and feel and glass doors are also available, with wired glass for an attractive, old-fashioned effect. The handles are also key features and are also in used-effect metal – such as the large "American" style handle that gives personality to the refrigerator door. The collection is based upon the concept of modularity, allowing for individual elements to be mixed and matched to find the perfect solution.
